

The mainstream media makes sure to get their leftwing narrative right—whether the facts support it or not. That’s fake news.

Author and commentator Andrew Klavan on the corruption of the leftist media: “Major news outlets, like ABC, NBC, CBS, and the still influential New York Times have now become so ideologically corrupt that they are engaging in the sort of Nixonian cover-ups they once prided themselves on exposing. Their studied creation of non-scandal scandals and non-gaffe gaffes on the right and their active suppression of such true scandals as Fast and Furious and Benghazi on the left amount to journalistic malpractice on behalf of the state.”

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The Left constantly complains about the bias of Fox News, but left-leaning ABC, CBS, NBC, MSNBC & CNN have almost ten times the viewers.

Though the Left complains about the dominance of Fox News among the cable news networks, the truth is the total number of viewers of all the left-leaning news channels, including CNN, NBC News, MSNBC, ABC News, CBS, and NPR, dwarf the total number of Fox News viewers.

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Author Andrew Klavan on the bias of the left-leaning mainstream media: “These outlets not only support Democrat candidates, they support a left-wing agenda, elevating and legitimizing minority and sexual grievance politics often based on misinformation.”

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Media bias fact: Only seven percent of American journalists identify as Republican.

Research by professors at Indiana University shows that, in 2013, only 7% of journalists identified with the Republican party.

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Democratic respondents outnumbered their Republican colleagues 4 to 1.

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The psychological reality of confirmation bias and groupthink suggests that journalists can only hope to be objective when working in a diverse environment with non like-minded journalists.

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A 2016 study by the Center for Public Integrity found that “more than 96 percent” of the money donated to presidential campaigns through August of that year “benefited Clinton.”

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Is the mainstream media biased? Just look at all the key players of the big-name outlets—they're Democrats and progressives.

Author Andrew Klavan on the bias of most of the mainstream media: "ABC's chief journalist is Clinton operative George Stephanopoulos. CBS's pro-Obama bias forced their best investigative reporter to quit. Until recently, NBC's top anchor was a perennial liar who once bowed to Obama as if he were a king. Brian Williams' replacements are no less biased toward the left."

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A recent study found that just 7% of journalists identified as Republican.

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Those who identified as Democrats outnumbered Republicans by 4 to 1.

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While many news outlets forbid reporters to donate to candidates, an overwhelming majority of those who gave in 2016, gave to Hillary.

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Left-leaning journalists claim that despite the fact they’re all Democrats, they can be objective. Psychologists say otherwise.

Recent psychology studies suggest that confirmation bias is a potentially “ubiquitous phenomenon” that impacts human reasoning in more ways than we had previously suspected.

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Author Andrew Klavan on the bias of the mainstream news media: “When people are sequestered among others of shared biases — as they are at ABC, CBS, and NBC — confirmation bias and groupthink take over. Their biases radicalize and they begin to mistake their opinions for the facts.”

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If leftwing journalists' biases are confirmed by a single event, it's treated as representative. If they're contradicted, it's dismissed.

Author Andrew Klavan's first rule of mainstream news coverage in America: When leftwing journalists have their prejudices confirmed, they treat the event as representative. When their prejudices are contradicted, the event is treated as an isolated event.

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When a scandal breaks on the right, the news is the scandal. When it breaks on the left, the news is: Who wrongfully disclosed it?!

Author Andrew Klavan's second rule of mainstream news coverage: When a scandal breaks on the right, the news is the scandal. When a scandal breaks on the left, what's important is where the information came from and how it was obtained.

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The leftist media highlights individual extremists on the right, but ignores the overall extremism of the left. That's fake news.

The left-leaning mainstream media praised the Occupy Wall Street movement, despite it being the epicenter of vandalism and violence.

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That same media slandered the Tea Party movement as racist and anti-Semitic, despite its peaceful and law-abiding gatherings.

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Fake News: Peaceful Tea Partiers who wanted the small government were radicals. Violent Occupiers who wanted socialism were heroes.

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
